### Role Purpose and Objectives

The West Midlands District is committed to starting new Christian communities in places, spaces and networks throughout the West Midlands as part of the connexional God for All strategy.   - allowing time to read all the required paperwork in advance,
  - becoming familiar with the national criteria so that proposals can be scrutinised according to the district oversight process,
  - holding the bigger financial, geographical and contextual picture in mind when considering individual proposals.
- Maintain good relationships with district NPNP staff.
